- Examination misconduct












## Where a student uses information such data, results, references, evidence that he or she has made up.










# Where one student has authorised another to use their work, in part or whole, and to submit it as their own










# Representing work or ideas of a third party as one's own by failing to correctly cite and reference others' work










# Where a student has used a third party or software to complete work either in whole or in part










## Where students have worked together on a piece of work, in part or whole, but submitted it as their own















## A low similarity index score on Turnitin means a higher grade




